Procedures for Submitting a Confidential, Anonymous Concern or Complaint

The Audit Committee of Century Capital Management Trust has adopted procedures for handling concerns and complaints related to the preparation of the financial statements of the Century Funds.

Officers of the Funds and employees of the Funds' Adviser and Service Providers who have a concern or complaint about accounting practices, internal accounting controls, or audit procedures used in connection with the preparation of the Funds' financial statements are encouraged to bring any such concern or complaint to the attention of the Funds' Chief Legal Officer. The Chief Legal Officer may be contacted by calling 617-482-3060 or by sending correspondence addressed to Century Capital Management, 100 Federal Street, 29th Floor, Boston, MA 02110 (Attn: Chief Legal Officer).

If an officer or employee wishes to submit a concern or complaint confidentially and anonymously, he or she may do so by omitting his or her name and indicating prominently on the submission that it is a "*Confidential and Anonymous Submission.*"
